
RULES

- Pre-school children may enter any pet category but must have adult support.


Schedule of Outdoor Exhibits





Exhibit Criteria and Rules

Class groups may be altered at the discretion of the Head Stewards.

For Years 1-6, each student allowed <u>only 1 entry per category</u>. All Categories marked with # can be entered in Group Day.

Entries should not be entered in successive years without significant modification.

Section A: Collections

Years 1 - 3 & 4 - 6

(classes can be changed based on number of entries at Head Steward's discretion)

A collection <u>should not</u> be entered in successive years, <u>unless</u> it has been majorly added to or improved. Judging will be done on the quality of display. These collections need to be contained either in the bottom of a box, fixed to cardboard/paper/wood.

Section B: Technology

Years 1 - 3 & 4 - 6


