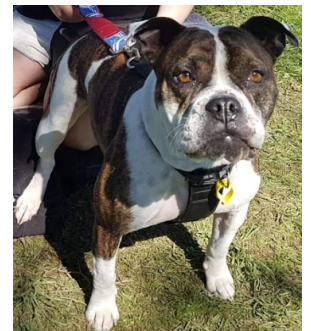

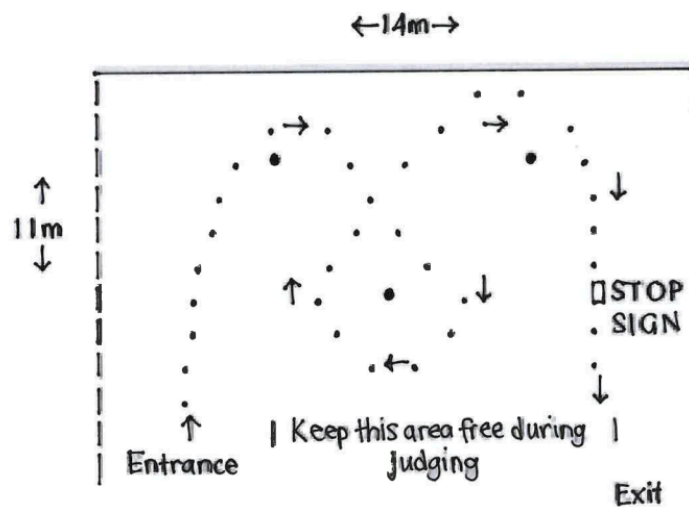
## RULES

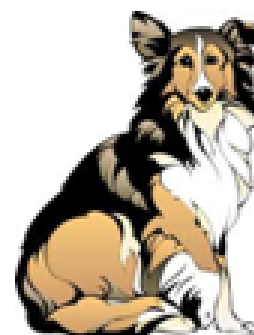

# Schedule of Indoor Exhibits

## Exhibit Criteria and Rules

Class groups may be altered at the discretion of the Head Stewards.

**For Years 1-6, each student allowed only 1 entry per category.**

**All Categories marked with # can be entered in Group Day.**

**Entries should not be entered in successive years without significant modification.**

## Section A: Collections

Years 1 - 3 & 4 - 6

**(classes can be changed based on number of entries at Head Steward's discretion)**

A collection **should not** be entered in successive years, **unless** it has been majorly added to or improved. Judging will be done on the quality of display.

These collections need to be contained either in the bottom of a box, fixed to cardboard/paper/wood.

1. Collections (on a fixed mount temporary or permanent)  
Stickers, Stamps etc, Toys, Books etc

## Section B: Technology

Years 1 - 3 & 4 - 6

**(classes can be changed based on number of entries at Head Steward's discretion)**

1. Models Your own design with no set instructions used - can be Lego, Meccano, Ken-X or any other brand
2. Hard Technology Any completed wood and metal work e.g bird-feeders
